We are transforming the Jetty Lane site and running it sustainably to enrich the lives of young people for generations to come. Leaving a gift to the charity will provide the means for us to create the facilities so greatly needed in this area.

To make the new Centre a reality, we need to raise at least £1.5m. Jetty Lane CIO will build a resource for our time, as well as for generations yet unborn - in this wonderful town.

MISSION

To provide a purpose-built, sustainable space for children and young people in the Woodbridge area and to be a leading Youth Hub for creativity and culture.

NEED

Since Woodbridge Youth Centre was demolished in 2017, our research shows that children and young people have missed out. Our facilities will provide programmed activities to ensure that children and young people have a space where they feel included and respected, where there is a sense of optimism and where new possibilities are opened up. Jetty Lane facilities will serve Woodbridge & surrounding villages. Our central site is accessible by public transport and there is ample parking.

DESIGN

We have a modern, sustainable design for two single-story buildings - a Youth Hub and a Business Hub - and a Playscape set within a garden. The whole site has been designed for us by architect Scott Mortimer in consultation with a group of local specialists.

FUNDING

Once built, the Centre will be self-funding by hiring out space both to community groups and to creative organisations. The activities in the Youth Hub and the Playscape will be subsidised by the commercial rents charged to the four units rented by compatible companies (including the children's charity Just42) in the Business Hub.

HOW YOU CAN GIVE

It really is as simple as that! You can agree on the words and type of gift which suits your circumstances with your adviser.

The most usual gift is a sum of money which can be any amount which suits your circumstances. The other types of gift are: A percentage of what you are worth, this is formally called a Residuary Gift. It can be 1% to 100% of your "estate". (Even 1% will help future generations). Gifts in Memory indicate to your friends and family that you would like Jetty Lane to benefit from any gifts/donations they may wish to give in your memory, and also any collections held at your funeral or memorial service.
